Discussion Re Race Day/Date Changes continued	Ed stated they were informed the proposed change would get these two tracks (EVD/LAD) "off of each other." The RC (at a meeting in the Spring) asked the HBPA to accept changes to 1) flip the two meets, 2) run all QH meets at DED, 3) start LAD meet earlier and EVD later, or 4) keep everything the same and cut race dates in a Legislative Session next year. The discussion then moved to the proposed changes to race dates, and members presented their reasons for disapproval of the changes, stating that the proposed changes would not improve racing at LAD due to other existing factors. Ed pointed out that the QH meet at EVD ends on April 6, so the change would only allow 8 days before the TB meet would begin on 8/14, and the TB meet at EVD would end on 10/7, so the QH meet would have to be delayed at EVD. Ronnie believed the issue goes back to the change of DED schedule two years ago, and he believed flexibility can be gained if DED went back to the mid-October to mid-March schedule. Benard stated DED was pushed forward to allow each of the four tracks at least a month to race alone. Ronnie reported the tracks put in their requests to run the same schedule and number of dates. The RC instructed the track/s to submit a schedule for 74 race days. The Board will communicate loudly to the RC that we are against the changes.
